Memorandum of Association for a Non-Profit Society

The name of the Society is the **Public Health Association of Nova Scotia**

On a volunteer and non-profit basis the objectives of the Society are:

- To work towards a society that supports a broad vision of health for Nova Scotians by advocating for policy change.
- To work towards enhancing the capacity of public health workers in Nova Scotia by providing networking and educational opportunities.
- To acquire by way of grant, gift, purchase, bequest, devise or otherwise, real and personal property and to use and apply such property to the realization of the objects of the Society;
- To buy, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or desirable in the carrying out of the objects of the Society.

Provided that:

- The Society shall not carry on any trade, industry, or business.
- All funds shall be used solely for the purposes of the Society and the promotion of its objects; no profits will accrue to any member.
- If the Society is terminated, wound up or dissolved and, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, there remains any property whatsoever, the same shall be paid to some other organization in Canada having objects similar to those of the society.

The activities of the Society are to be carried on in Nova Scotia.
